MILITARY RECRUITMENT

POLICY #853

The Mt. Horeb Area School District recognizes the fact that our country's security is based upon a well selected volunteer armed service. Also, joining the Armed Forces is a legitimate career alternative for students to consider.

1. Any military personnel or their representative may be present at Mt. Horeb High School. These contacts will be limited to twice each semester per military branch for the purpose of communicating, informing, and educating students who may be interested in the opportunities which exist in the military.
2. All requests from military personnel for school visits, conferences, or class presentations will be directed to the Guidance Office, where the scheduling of such requests will be coordinated.
3. All visitations must be set up at least one week in advance for the following reasons:
 - a. To ensure that students can be informed of the upcoming visitation through school announcements;
 - b. To allow students to adjust their schedule so that arrangements can be made with teachers for the purpose of class make-up time.
 - c. To ensure that the time which has been requested by the respective recruiter is not in conflict with other appointments which may be scheduled in the Guidance Office.
4. Special events such as Career Day, class presentations, which have been approved in advance by a representative of Mt. Horeb High School, special awards programs, or the collection of student transcript records, etc., will not be included in the restrictions which are stated in #1 above.
5. In a continuing effort to provide access to students who have expressed an interest in the military, the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) will be offered in November as an optional program for Mt. Horeb High School juniors and seniors.
6. In an effort to protect Mt. Horeb High School student privacy, the District policy on Student Directory Data will be followed.
