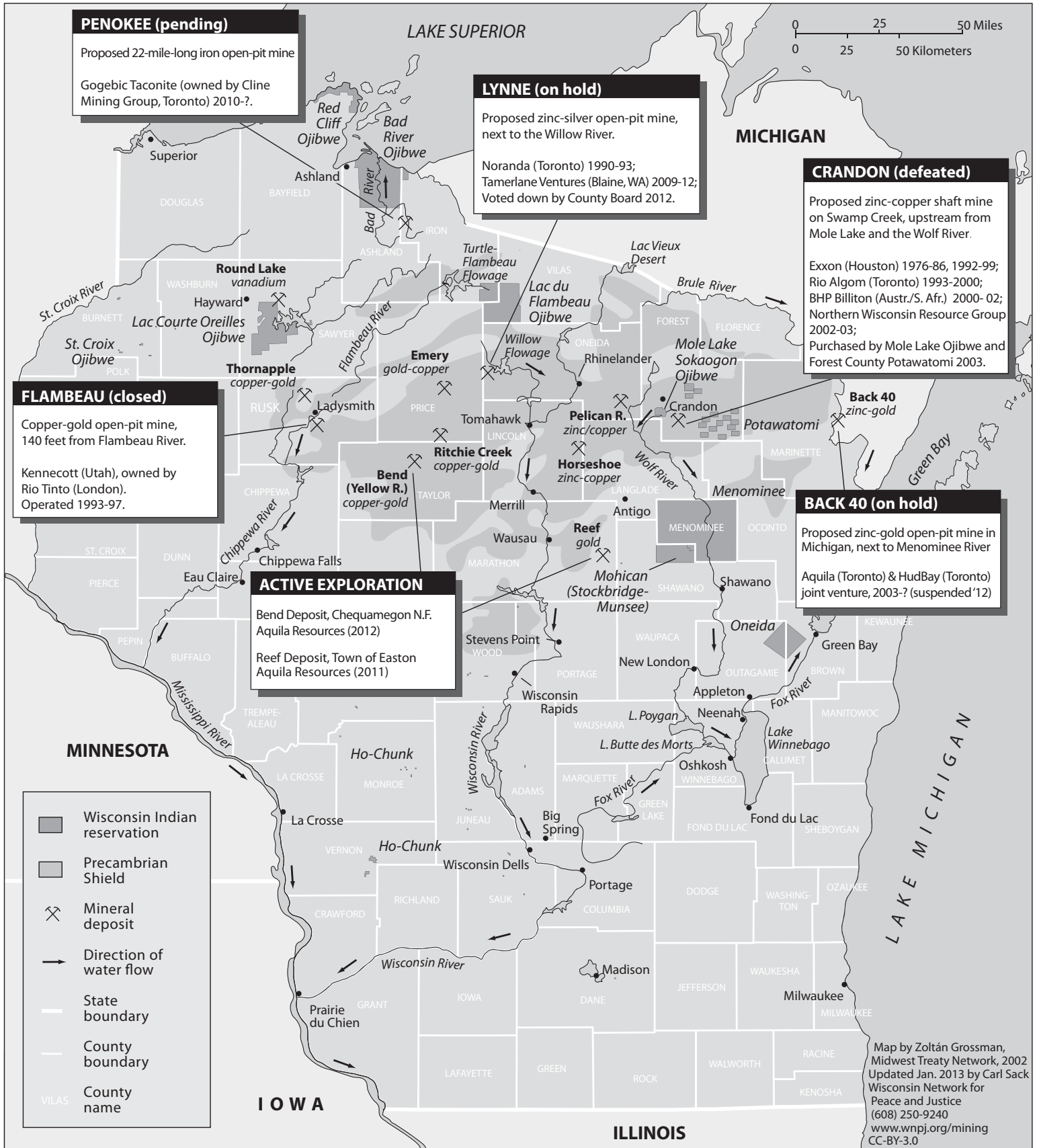


Mining in Northern Wisconsin

 Noranda (Toronto) 1990-93;
 Tamerlane Ventures (Blaine, WA) 2009-12;
 Voted down by County Board 2012.

CRANDON (defeated)
 Proposed zinc-copper shaft mine on Swamp Creek, upstream from Mole Lake and the Wolf River.
 Exxon (Houston) 1976-86, 1992-99;
 Rio Algom (Toronto) 1993-2000;
 BHP Billiton (Austr./S. Afr.) 2000-02;
 Northern Wisconsin Resource Group 2002-03;
 Purchased by Mole Lake Ojibwe and Forest County Potawatomi 2003.

FLAMBEAU (closed)
 Copper-gold open-pit mine, 140 feet from Flambeau River.
 Kennecott (Utah), owned by Rio Tinto (London).
 Operated 1993-97.
